### **ORLANDO HABITAT BUYING HOMES IN FORECLOSURE**

Habitat for Humanity of Greater Orlando got \$1 million from Orange County to buy and renovate up to 12 foreclosed homes for low-income families as part of the U.S. Housing & Urban Development's Neighborhood Stabilization Program.

Orange County got \$11.5 million through the program and plans to target the Pine Hills area with these funds.

Habitat will invest about \$40,000 into each home for items such as air conditioning, appliance installation, roof repairs and fixture replacements. It already bought two homes to renovate with the award.
