**LOCAL COMPANIES DONATE TIME, SERVICES AND PRODUCTS
TO HABITAT FOR HUMANITY ORLANDO**
Donors' Contributions Help Build the Staghorn Villas Community

ORLANDO, Fla. – Nine local companies have made in-kind donations – contributions of time, services or products – to help Habitat for Humanity Orlando complete its largest homebuilding effort to date: Staghorn Villas. Each donor committed support for the duration of construction, which is slated for completion in 2011.

Below are the current local donors, listed by the magnitude of their donation:

- Whirlpool donated a stovetop range, refrigerator and discounted washer and dryer for each townhome.

homes,” said Dee Danmeyer, executive director of Habitat for Humanity Orlando. “And we are grateful for the support from these nine companies to help expand affordable housing and make the reality of homeownership possible for Central Florida families.”

Once complete, the 3.9-acre neighborhood will provide affordable homes for 58 local families. Six families have already moved into the first completed building, and the second building is scheduled for completion in mid-July. Located on Stag Horn Drive and Silver Star Road, the community will feature 10 buildings, each of which include four to eight townhomes surrounded by green spaces and play areas.
